Current Opportunities for English teaching professionals.

Background:

Vostek is a recruitment consultancy with offices in the United Kingdom and Australia. We specialize in helping overseas nurses gain the necessary orientation and qualifications to become registered with the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Council (ANMC).

Currently we have three areas of opportunity for those English teaching professionals who would enjoy working with overseas student nurses. We have opportunities both here in South East Queensland and in India.

We can accommodate all levels of teaching experience starting from trainee English teachers; seeking valuable experience from working with willing students, through to very experienced teaching professionals who may be able to further develop our teaching program and training materials.

Experience or a desire to learn more about Occupational English Training (OET) is an advantage; however existing experience in IELTS or ELICOS is still very much valued and relevant to the scenarios below:

Scenario 1.

Vostek is assisting a small group of nurses who are currently working in Beenleigh. They are originally from India and have studied at graduate-level in Australia.

Most already have either an IELTS of 6.5 or an average band score of “B” in the Reading, Listening and Speaking modules of the OET test. The objective is to bring up their Writing module up from a “C” to a “B” therefore allowing them to register with the relevant Nursing Council.

Because the group is small – maybe only two candidates at present, we can be very flexible on location and teaching hours.

We seek a professional to work with us on an hourly wage agreement to assess and guide us on what areas of weakness need to be addressed as to get the candidates up to the required level of English to register as nurses.

Scenario 2.

Vostek have been asked to provide approximately 20 overseas nurses from India for a twelve month orientation to the Australian healthcare system. As part of this orientation, we would like to add an English component of perhaps half a day per month over a 12 month period.

We seek a professional(s) who would be interested in developing an English syllabus with us for the candidates. Logistically, the English professional would have to travel locally to the teaching venue – however all costs incurred would be covered on top of the hourly rate.

Teaching resources such as a projector, photocopier and internet access will be provided by us. Potentially, we will be able to provide teaching materials as well however any teaching materials that could be contributed would add value and would be appropriately remunerated.

These candidates are welcome to work with the teaching professional on an individual basis outside these hours as long as the hourly rate asked for is reasonable. Furthermore there may be paid opportunities for developing teaching materials that could benefit all involved.

As with all of the candidates, these nurses already have studied in the English language and therefore their English level is high.

Scenario 3.

We have a number of teaching opportunities in India. As well as an appropriate wage, all airfares, accommodation (to a good standard), mobile phone, visas and teaching facilities are provided.

The duration of such trips is approximately 2 – 3 weeks depending on the schedule.

During this time you will be working closely with a group of students and other English teachers based in India. There is one class in the morning and another in the late afternoon five days per week. There will be some one-on-one work with candidates that are very close to passing the OET examination.

There will be plenty of opportunities for weekend travel and of course we shall show you all of the sights!
